



﴿1﴾ Bath oneself

Narrations have mentioned that it is recommended to bathe oneself on this day

﴿2﴾ Fasting

and to observe fasting on it, which achieves the forgiveness of all sins, both the past and the future.

﴿3﴾ Offer Salat SALMAN Farsi

It is also recommended to offer Salat Salman.

It is recommended to begin with offering the famous **Salat Salman** (The Prayer of Salmin al-Farsi), which consists of ten units of this prayer separating each couple with a *Taslem*.

In each unit, one should recite [Surah al-Fatehah](#) one time, [Surah al-Tawhed](#) three times, and [Surah al-Kafirun](#) three times.

After *Taslem*, it is recommended to raise the hands up and say the following :

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ

There is no god save Allah, the One and Only Who has no partner.

لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ

To him is the kingdom and to Him is all praise.

يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ وَهُوَ حَيٌّ لَا يَمُوتُ

He gives life and causes to die while He is Ever-living and never dies.

بِيَدِهِ الْخَيْرُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

In His hand is the good and He has power over all things.

The following litany should be said thereafter:

اللَّهُمَّ لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا أَعْطَيْتَ

O Allah, verily, none can ever divest him whom You decide to give,

وَلَا مُعْطِي لِمَا مَنَعْتَ

none can ever give him whom You decide to deprive,

وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا الْجَدِّ مِنْكَ الْجَدُّ

and nothing can ever stop that which You decide.



The Last DAY of Rajab

Extract from Mafateeh | Month of Rajab | Dua-Aamal

Then, one should pass the hands over the face.

إِلَهًا وَاحِدًا أَحَدًا فَرْدًا صَمَدًا، لَمْ يَتَّخِذْ صَاحِبَةً وَلَا وُلْدًا

One, Unique, and eternally Besought of all. He has taken to Himself neither a wife nor a son.

Offer this prayer on the **last day of Rajab** in this very form; rather, the following litany is added after the first one

عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ:

وَصَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِهِ الطَّاهِرِينَ

May Allah send blessings to Muhammad and upon his Household, the Immaculate.

وَلَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ الْعَلِيِّ الْعَظِيمِ-

There is neither might nor power save with Allah, the Most High, the All-great.

Then, one should pass the hands over the face and submit his requests.

This greatly advantageous prayer must not be neglected.

This prayer brings about a great reward; it achieves forgiveness of all sins, protects against the grave torture and the chastisement on the Resurrection Day, and saves from leprosy, elephantiasis, and pleurisy.

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
